No referral criteria thresholds

Registration

When you access Spire Connect for the first time you will be required to register a few personal details to allow you access to the site and grant you permission to make referrals.

Making a referral

To make a referral click on the 'Make an online referral' link and complete all relevant details.

Imaging and other referral types

You can make referrals for radiological investigations such as MRI, CT and ultrasound by selecting 'Imaging referral' under – 'Type of referral'. Please note, all radiology referrals must be signed by a GP. To make a referral for physiotherapy, select under 'Allied Health Professionals' in the specialty list.

Attaching patient notes

It is possible to attach patient notes to the form, however the ease of this will depend on your own patient record software. Take a look at the options available in your software to see if records can be 'exported' or 'saved as' to your desktop. Then from there you can attach them to this form. You will need to save the notes in a common format such as a text or word document (.rtf, .pdf, .doc, .txt), a spreadsheet (.xls or .csv) or an image format (eg .bmp, .jpg). Then click the 'submit' button at the bottom of the page to send the referral.

At Spire Cambridge Lea Hospital we have specialist Consultant Ophthalmologists offering a wide range of treatments for common eye conditions in our dedicated Eye Centre.

Cataract surgery:

- A range of intraocular lenses including monofocal, multifocal, toric and multifocal toric
- Biometry for intra ocular lenses (IOL)
- Pentacam topography for astigmatism and toric IOL's

Allergy

Dr Andrew Clark

Comprehensive allergy service, including testing and management of food allergies in infants and older children (egg, milk, nuts etc), anaphylaxis, seasonal and perennial rhinitis, eczema, asthma and recurrent urticaria in children.

B

Breast surgery

Mr Amit Agrawal

Advanced oncoplastic lumpectomy (mammoplasty, mastopexy, fat modelling, partial breast reconstruction with perforator flap), reconstruction whole breast (with implant, LD flap, TDAP flap), nipple reconstruction, other procedures such as augmentation, reduction, routine breast surgery (including lumpectomy, mastectomy, lymph node surgery).

Mr Parto Forouhi

Breast disease, breast surgery, diagnosis and treatment of benign breast disease and breast cancer, breast pain, breast lumps, breast cysts, diagnosis and treatment of male breast problems. Paediatric assessment of breast problems. Breast cancer surgery techniques for breast aesthetics. Breast ultrasound, including intraoperative breast ultrasound (non-palpable abnormalities). General surgery: diagnosis and treatment of cutaneous and subcutaneous lumps.

C

Cardiology

Dr Rajinder Bilku

General cardiology, devices, heart failure, heart disease, arrhythmia, imaging including echocardiography, chest pain, dizziness, heart murmurs, valve disease, palpitations, hypertension, shortness of breath.

Dr Sarah Clarke

General cardiology, heart disease prevention, chest pain, heart murmurs, heart palpitations, dizziness, hypertension, shortness of breath, coronary angiography and coronary intervention.

Dr Fady Magdy

General cardiology (eg. high blood pressure, palpitations, valvular heart disease, breathlessness). Specialising in the assessment and management of heart failure as well as the assessment of new onset chest pain using cardiac CT. A special interest in cardio-oncology.

Dr Michael O'Sullivan

General cardiology, dizziness, chest pain, heart murmurs, heart palpitations, hypertension, shortness of breath, cardiac risk assessment, angina, heart failure, coronary angiography, coronary stenting, aortic valve intervention (transcatheter aortic valve intervention, TAVI).

Dr Peter Schofield

General cardiology, chest pain, palpitations, murmurs, dizziness, hypertension, shortness of breath, coronary angiography.

Dr Leonard Shapiro

General cardiology, chest pain, palpitations, murmurs, dizziness, hypertension, shortness of breath and expertise in the heart of athletes. Performs echocardiography in clinic personally and can place 24–48-hour ECG recorders whilst in the clinic.

Dr Yogen Singh

Paediatric cardiology, congenital heart conditions (CHDs), echocardiography (echo), palpitations and cardiac arrhythmias, screening for heart problems in young adults and children.

Chest physicians

Dr Robert Buttery

General respiratory medicine, EBUS and medical thoracoscopy, lung cancer, lung diagnostics, lung oncology, mesothelioma, asthma, pneumonia, bronchiectasis, pulmonary fibrosis.

Dr Ravi Mahadeva

Outpatient assessment of respiratory symptoms such as breathlessness, cough, wheeze, shortness of breath and second opinions on wide range of respiratory disease such as asthma, COPD, bronchiectasis.

D

Dermatology

Dr Anton Alexandroff

General dermatology (adult and paediatric), treatment of resistant viral warts and verrucas including diphenylprone therapy, treatment for malignant skin cancer, inflammatory skin diseases including psoriasis, dermatitis, acne, skin cancers including basal cell cancer (BCC), squamous cell cancer (SCC) and malignant melanoma, diagnosis and management of various types of hair loss (eg alopecia).

Dr Nevianna Bordet

General dermatology (adult and paediatric), benign and malignant skin lesions, vulval dermatology, hair and nail disease, inflammatory skin disease, treatment of malignant skin cancer, dermatitis, acne, eczema, psoriasis and warts.

Dr Nigel Burrows

General dermatology (adult and paediatric), assessment and treatment of benign (including moles, cysts) and malignant skin lesions.

Dr Paul Norris

General adult dermatology, skin lesions, including suspected skin cancer, sun damage, cryotherapy and photodynamic therapy.

Dr Pamela Todd

General dermatology (adult and paediatric), vulval disorders, melanoma, pigmented lesions, patch testing for contact allergy, general skin complaints, fungal infections (skin and nail).

E

Endocrinology

Dr Samer Alsabbagh

General endocrinology, thyroid disease, parathyroid glands, hypogonadism, ED, PCOS, menopause, pituitary and adrenal diabetes and prediabetes, diabetic neuropathy and diabetic nephropathy weight management and hyponatraemia.

Dr Jeannie Todd

General endocrinology, adrenal, PCOS, hirsutism, prolactin disorders, pituitary diseases, calcium / bone / parathyroid metabolism as well as diabetes, thyroid, alopecia and neuroendocrine tumours.

ENT

Mr Furrat Amen

Adult and paediatric ENT, head and neck cancer, thyroid, glue ear, tongue tie, voice disorders, allergies, nosebleeds, hearing, airway disease, nasal polyps, poor sense of smell, sinusitis, irritation of the throat, rhinoplasty.

Mr Patrick Axon

Adult and paediatric ear disease including wax removal. All forms of hearing loss and balance disorders. Glue ear, cholesteatoma and childhood ear infection. Deafness requiring stapedectomy, ossiculoplasty, hearing aids or hearing implantation. Management of skull base pathology including vestibular schwannoma. Tinnitus management including pulsatile tinnitus.

Professor Manohar Bance

Ear surgery, hearing reconstruction surgery, cochlear implants, bone conduction hearing implants, mastoidectomy, eustachian tube surgery, tympanoplasty, stapedotomy, vertigo imbalance, otology, neurotology, skull base surgery, Ménière's disease and endolymphatic sac surgery and middle ear myoclonus.

Mr Daniele Borsetto

Combined approach tympanoplasty, mastoidectomy, tympanoplasty, ossiculoplasty, stapedectomy, adenoidectomy, FESS, flexible nasoendoscopy / laryngoscopy, vestibular assessment, hearing test, balloon sinuplasty treatment for chronic sinusitis, sinus surgery, grommets insertion, tonsillectomy, balance disorders, head and neck pathology, neurotology, otology, paediatric otolaryngology, MRI and general ENT.

Mr Neil Donnelly

Adult and paediatric ENT, sinus surgery, grommets insertion, laryngoscopy investigation, tonsillectomy, hearing loss, dizziness, vertigo, balance disorder, ear infections, ear wax, cochlear implants, middle ear implants, skull base tumours, vestibular schwannoma, pituitary tumour.

Mr Brian Fish

Adult and paediatric ENT, investigation and treatment of throat and neck abnormalities. Neck lumps, salivary gland disorders, thyroid and parathyroid surgery, laryngoscopy/stroboscopy investigation for voice conditions, swallowing disorders, nasal and sinus surgery, tonsillectomy, grommets insertion, snoring, investigation and treatment of head and neck cancers.

Miss Ekpemi Irun

Cancer tests, neck lumps, thyroid surgery, salivary gland disorders, throat problems, voice problems, nose reshaping (rhinoplasty), tonsillectomy, septoplasty surgery, scar revision, robotic surgery, cancer of the head and neck (diagnosis and surgery), snoring issues, swallowing problems, ear microscopy, flexible nasal laryngoscopy and stroboscopy, rigid nasal endoscopy, trans-nasal oesophagoscopy (tno), anti-wrinkle treatment with Botox and fillers.

General adult and paediatric ENT, neck lumps, thyroids, salivary glands, nasal conditions, sleep disorders, laryngology, thyroid surgery, parathyroid surgery, rhinology.

Specialist paediatric and general adult ENT: tonsil and adenoid related problems, snoring, croup, sleep apnoea, airway problems, tonsillectomy, adenoidectomy, hearing problems, glue ear, grommets insertion. Laryngoscopy investigation, septoplasty surgery, sinus surgery, investigation and treatment of neck lumps, tongue tie.

Adult and paediatric ENT, sinus surgery, nasal polyps, recurrent sinusitis, rhinology, balloon sinuplasty, primary and revision rhinoplasty, septal surgery, correction of prominent ears, facial lesions and local flaps, cosmetic and functional rhinoplasty.

Gastroenterology

Acid reflux and indigestion, abdominal pain, irritable bowel syndrome, gallstones, pancreatitis, inflammatory bowel diseases including Crohn's disease and ulcerative colitis, coeliac disease, diarrhoea, constipation, bowel cancer screening, bowel polyps, anaemia, unexplained symptoms, colonoscopy, gastroscopy, flexible sigmoidoscopy, capsule endoscopy and advanced therapeutic endoscopic procedures.

Colonoscopy, flexible sigmoidoscopy, gastroscopy for investigation of abdominal symptoms including change in bowel pattern (diarrhoea, constipation), rectal bleeding and abdominal pain, colon polyps, inflammatory bowel disease, Crohn's disease, ulcerative colitis.

Dr Philip Roberts

Colonoscopy, flexible sigmoidoscopy, gastroscopy, inflammatory bowel disease, gastro-oesophageal reflux, dyspepsia, irritable bowel syndrome. Change in bowel habits and abdominal pain.

Bowel cancer screening specialist, colonoscopy, flexible sigmoidoscopy, gastroscopy, irritable bowel disease, inflammatory bowel syndrome, therapeutic endoscopy, dyspepsia.

Diagnostic and therapeutic endoscopic procedures including polypectomy, colonoscopy, flexible sigmoidoscopy, gastroscopy, endoscopic ultrasound (diagnostic and therapeutic EUS), pancreatitis and pancreatic disorders, inflammatory bowel disease, irritable bowel syndrome, gastro-oesophageal reflux disease and Barrett's oesophagus, coeliac disease, glucose and lactose hydrogen breath test, change in bowel habit (diarrhoea and constipation), rectal bleeding and abdominal pain.

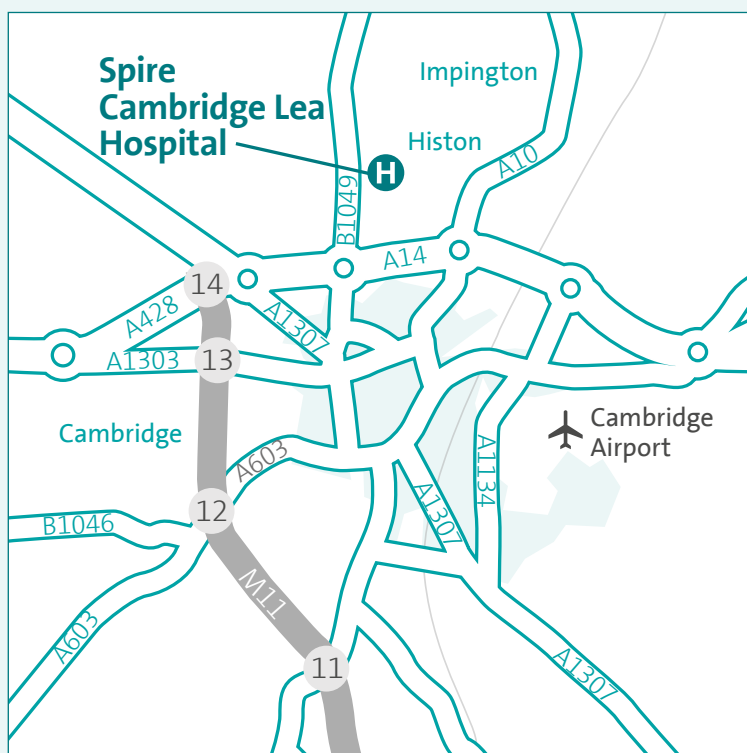
